Important Message for Kin Kora Parents

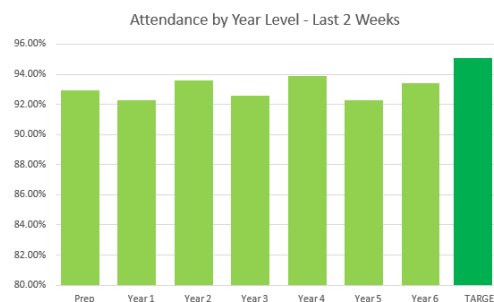
Exciting News! We are going paperless for report cards this semester! All parents will be able to access their child's report through Q-Parents in Week 9.
